

Accessibility

- Parking** There is street parking immediately outside the practice. There is also staff parking at the rear of the practice which could be used with prior arrangement.
- Entrance** The name of the practice is clearly visible from the pavement. There is a curb to negotiate although a short distance away there is a drop in the curb. When on the pavement the entrance path is level. There is a small lip into the entrance hall and a ramp has been installed for easier access for wheelchair users and pushchairs. The door is wide enough for wheelchair users.
- Reception** Signage is clear, short and simple. Waiting areas and corridors are free of clutter and floors are not slippery. Well-lit with natural and artificial lighting. Low counter available. Handrails are in place on each side of the stairs.
- Doors** Both entrance doors into the practice have low level door handles. Both doors are wide enough for wheelchair users.
- Surgeries** There is a ground floor surgery available for patients unable to climb the stairs to the upstairs surgeries. This surgery has to be requested at the time of registering at the practice or booking an appointment.
- Toilet** There is a ground floor low level toilet and wash basin with support aids designed for disabled use.
